Dear Parents/Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you and your family well and that you are looking forward to your child returning to school on Thursday next. As you can imagine, our number one priority continues to be the wellbeing and safety of our school community. We are returning this time to a calmer and more familiar mode of operation which hopefully the children feel too. While this virus remains a constant threat which we must be ever vigilant of, we know now from the experience of the last school year what we can do at school to prevent the spread of the virus and how we can make the children feel safe and confident at school with us. We have been advised by the Department of Education to continue with the protocols and safety measures we had in place last year and this is what we are doing. All the measures we have taken are in line with the guidelines we received from the Department of Education and are compliant with public health guidelines.

It is our intention to continue with staggered drop off and collection times to avoid a large accumulation of cars/people outside the school. We would encourage all parents to stick as rigidly as possible to their times and staff will ensure that children are ready to leave at their times to help minimise the school gate/drop off area. Please wear masks and continue with social distancing when on school grounds.
