Digital Learning Plan

As part of our digital learning plan, all classes engaged in coding in term 2. Juniors and Seniors did simple coding with beebots. 1st class created animations with scratch junior on the ipads. 2nd to 4th class coded their lego creations using WeDo. 5th and 6th class used Lego Spike Prime. Lots of classes used the ipads and chromebooks to showcase and support their learning. 1st to 6th class also engaged with online safety activities. Our pupils love developing their digital skills.

Gaeilge

During this school year 22/23 we are reviewing our Gaeilge School Improvement Plan. Our focus is Teanga Ó Bhéal (oral language) in Irish. We are promoting this through playful, collaborative and engaging opportunities to practice conversing with each other through Irish. We use phrases of the week in each class and encourage children to use Gaeilge informally outside of the Gaeilge lesson. Beatha teanga í a labhairt.

Wellbeing

As part of the SSE process for improving well-being in our school community, we have created staff and pupil focus groups to identify areas for improvement. A parent focus group will be created in term 3. When all the feedback is collated, a priority area will be identified. The review of our Healthy Eating policy was also undertaken as part of this process. This is being conducted in consultation with pupils, parents and staff.
