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## School Motto

This ethos is clearly evident to any visitor to the school. A curious, enquiring mind, which is fulfilled by guided discovery and learning is a natural state for each child. Our aim is to create a teaching and learning environment in which this takes place. The fullest growth and development of each child is best achieved in a pleasant, harmonious, happy atmosphere where positive relationships are promoted. This involves the co-operation of the whole school community in a team approach – pupils, staff, parents, Board of Management and the wider community.

## Welcome

Lisnagry National School is a co-educational primary school in the Parish of Castleconnell catering for the education of children from Junior Infants to 6th class. The current enrolment is 295 pupils. We have 13 mainstream class teachers, 5 support teachers, 3 Special Needs Assistants, a school secretary, a cleaner and a caretaker. Owing to the efforts of parents, staff and the Board of Management, the present school boasts the most modern facilities with spacious classrooms, up to date equipment and an all weather playground.



Since its foundation the school has developed into one of the best known educational establishments in Limerick. As well as being taught a broad and balanced curriculum, the pupils are encouraged to engage in many extra curricular activities.

### Morning and After School Club

Childcare is available on site from 8am until school starts and from 1.40 to 6pm. It offers a fully insured, safe environment, indoor hall available for activities during inclement weather and a separate homework and play areas.



### Hot Lunches

Gourmet Kids provides free hot school lunches for all our pupils in line with the EU Child Guarantee Scheme (funded by the Department of Social Welfare).

### School Building

We have a modern school building containing spacious modern well equipped classrooms, a large school hall and support teaching rooms.

### Ball Wall

We have an 18 metre x 5 metre ball wall where children can practice their hurling and football skills.





## Running and Walking Track

Our newly constructed all-weather walking and running track contains two lanes and is 300 metres long.

## Astro Turf

We have two astro-turf areas – one pitch and one astro-turf area in front of the ball wall.

## Yards and Pitches

We have a large school pitch, tarmac area, basketball court and another playground area.

## School Concerts

At Christmas time the classes perform a play or have a choral afternoon in the school hall. We also perform a whole school musical in the TUS theatre every few years.

## Yoga / Swimming

Children receive a number of weeks tuition from a professional yoga instructor and children in 3rd and 4th class receive six swimming lessons throughout the year.

## Club Coaching

Ahane G.A.A. club provide a club coach during the year with classes benefiting from this tuition.

## After School Activities

School staff offer choir, chess, football, basketball, soccer, hurling/camogie training after school.

## Speech and Drama

Speech & Drama lessons are available immediately after school with Cushla Hehir.

## Irish Dancing

Corless Academy provide Irish dancing classes after school each Tuesday.

## Traditional Irish Music

Comhaltas provide traditional Irish music classes school after each Monday.



## Karate

Michael Hogan teaches karate lessons Tuesday and Thursday evenings in the school hall.

## Science Club

A science club runs every Wednesday after school in the school hall.
